Subject: Important Information Regarding Three-Language Policy for Grade IX (Academic Session 2026–27)

Dear Parents,

Greetings from Dev-In National School...!

We would like to inform you about the recent guidelines issued by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) regarding the implementation of the **Three-Language Policy** for students of **Grade IX** from the **Academic Session 2026–27**, in alignment with the recommendations of the National Curriculum Framework (NCF).

As per the new policy, all students of Grade IX are required to study **three languages**, with the condition that **at least two of them must be Indian languages**.

For your child, Dev-In National School offers the following language options:

- **First Language (R1): English**
- **Second Language (R2): Kannada / Hindi / Sanskrit – Indian language**
- **Third Language (R3): Kannada / Hindi / Sanskrit – Indian language**

In accordance with the rules of the Government of Karnataka, **Kannada is compulsory as one of the languages for every child studying in Karnataka**. Therefore, it is mandatory for students to choose Kannada as one of their language options.

Further, as per the CBSE guidelines:

- The **Third Language (R3)** will be taught at the **Grade VI level**.
- There will be no **Board Examination for R3 in Grade X**.
- However, the **marks obtained in the school examination for R3 will be reflected in the Grade X Marks Card/Certificate**.

CBSE has also issued detailed syllabi for Art Education and Physical Education and is closely monitoring the conduct of activities and evaluations in these internal subjects. Parents are requested to ensure that their ward gives equal importance to these subjects along with the main academic subjects.

We request you to kindly take note of the above changes and guide your child in adapting to the revised language requirements. We appreciate your cooperation and continued support.
